



If you are a refugee from Bhutan and are registered with the Government of Nepal and UNHCR during the recent census, and you are interested in applying for third country resettlement, you may print and fill out a [Declaration of Interest \(http://www.un.org.np/unhcr/Declaration-of-interest-eng.pdf\)](http://www.un.org.np/unhcr/Declaration-of-interest-eng.pdf) form available here. You may also pick-up a Declaration of Interest form throughout all seven refugee camps at the following locations: RCU, FA, BRAVV, BRWF, Disability Centre, Children's Forum, Health Centre, LWF, Caritas Administration, and the Vajra Foundation. Declarations of Interest forms are also available at the UNHCR Office in Damak or Kathmandu.

When you or your family are completing the form, all members of your household who would like to apply for resettlement and are adults over the age of 18 should be listed separately on the form. Each adult family member who is interested in resettlement must clearly print their name and place their signature on the Declaration of Interest form to confirm their interest in resettlement.

You will then need to place your completed forms in one of the suggestions boxes which you will find in all seven refugee camps in the following locations: outside the police post, RCU office, FA office and inside the AMDA office. You may also deliver your completed forms to UNHCR Offices in Damak or Kathmandu.

All applications will be treated on a first come first serve basis and handled by UNHCR.

If you need help understanding or completing a Declaration of Interest form, UNHCR Durable Solutions staff will be in the camp every week to assist you and answer any questions you may have about the process.

In Damak, all questions about resettlement can be addressed to UNHCR staff who will be visiting the camps regularly: it is not necessary to come to the UNHCR Office in Damak to apply for resettlement or to ask questions about resettlement.

In Kathmandu, all questions about resettlement can be addressed to the UNHCR office in person, by phone or in writing on Monday, Wednesday and Friday afternoons between 2:30 - 5:00.
