

## Third Country Resettlement Procedure Overview

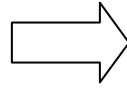
### APPLICATION

**Declaration of Interest**

**Who?** Resettlement is open to any refugee registered without discrimination regardless of age, family, medical status, gender, education level, work experience, religion, or ethnicity.

**What?** You can fill out a Declaration of Interest Form. If you need assistance in filling out these forms, contact UNHCR.

**Where?** The forms will be available at several locations throughout the camps, the UNHCR Office in Damak and UNHCR in Kathmandu and on the UN Nepal Information Platform.



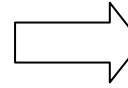
### UNHCR INTERVIEW

**UNHCR Interview**

**Who?** UNHCR will call you and your family in for an interview to verify your identity and confirm your wish to resettle.

**What?** Adults will be asked to sign an Agreement to Resettlement Referral form to confirm their desire to apply for resettlement. UNHCR will consider your case for submission to a resettlement country.

**Where?** UNHCR will inform applicants of where the verification interviews will take place.



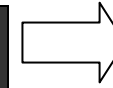
### RESETTLEMENT COUNTRY PROCESSING

**Resettlement Country Processing**

**Who?** Once a case has been submitted to a resettlement country, refugees will undergo processing by the resettlement country.

**What?** Depending on the resettlement country, the process can involve one or more interviews and medical examinations.

**Where?** UNHCR or the resettlement country will contact the applicant to inform them of where the processing will take place.



### DECISION

**Decision**

The government of the resettlement country will determine whether they accept your application for resettlement or deny your application.

If you are accepted, then the International Organization for Migration (IOM) will facilitate your departure the resettlement country.

If you are rejected by a resettlement country you are still eligible to apply for resettlement to a different third country in the future.



Throughout the entire process UNHCR will regularly be in each camp every week to answer questions about any of the durable solution options.
