DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITY:

The Generator mechanic will report to the Facility Manager in the respective region and will be responsible for the generator/electrical power system throughout the regional office as follows:

- Implement the initial installation of generators in the range of 2 Kva to 700 Kva. including external fuel tanks and fuel pipes.
- Operate a wide-range of high voltage panels, such as control panels, automatic change over Panels, transfer switches, synchronization panels, alarm and emergency shut down devices.
- Plan and implement comprehensive maintenance and service program for all UNMIN owned generators and associated control panels, ranging from routine "A" maintenance to complete overhaul on both the engine as well as the alternator.
- Troubleshoot, analyze and repair both generator and alternator, sometimes under difficult conditions out in the field. Monitor the usage of Diesel Fuel.
- Act as standby generator/electrical technician on a weekly roster basis as scheduled/required.
- Overnight in the various sectors on a team basis when required to facilitate the repair or maintenance of generators and electrical systems.
- Perform other duties as required.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Education: Completion of Secondary/High School education with confirmed Diploma/Certificate. Basic computing skills.

Experience: A minimum of 3-5 years experience in Generator/Mechanic/Electrical power systems. Training as an apprentice, Engineer or Technician in an appropriate field such as Mechanic, Diesel fitter/mechanic, Plant mechanic, Generator mechanic or Mechanical engineer and recognized qualifications is an asset.

Languages: Knowledge of written and spoken communications skills in both English and Nepali, and the regional languages.

Other skills: Possess a driving license for 4x4 Sedans and Pick-ups, and must be prepared to travel long distances as required, by surface transport as well as air.

COMPETENCIES:

Professionalism: Ability to maintain a professional attitude and to work efficiently in a stressful environment. Knowledge/ability to actively participate in the use of Personal Protective Equipment and act in a safe and responsible manner.

Teamwork: Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships in a multi-cultural, multi-ethnic environment with sensitivity and respect for diversity, including commitment to the goal of implementing gender equality.

Communication: Good written and spoken communication skills in English, Nepali and the regional languages.
