

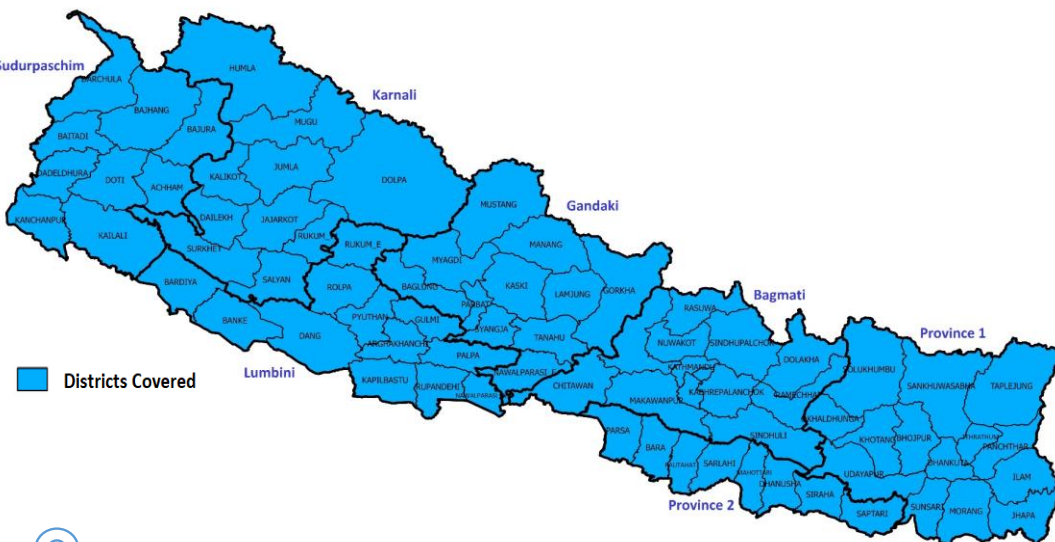

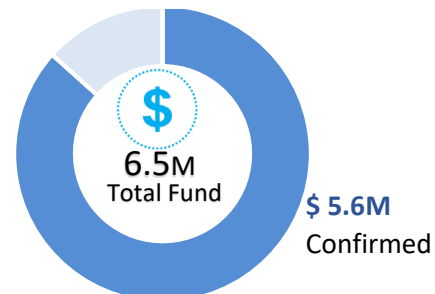

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS



268,850 people reached with **2,159** handwashing station installed in communities, quarantine centres, health care facilities, isolation centres and points of entry



13 federal hospitals, **61** COVID-19 hospitals in 53 districts and 139 (Health Posts, Primary Health Care Centers, Urban Health Clinics and Community Health Units) supported with critical WASH supplies



214 toilets constructed in health care facilities, quarantine and Isolation centres



159 water storage tanks of capacity 100 to 1,000 litres provided to quarantine centres

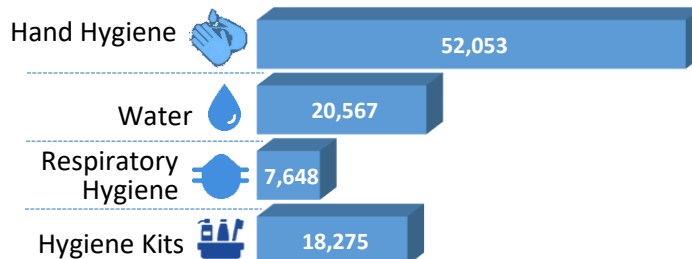


2,450 Kg of bleaching powder supported to health care facilities, isolation and quarantine centres, point of entry and community
