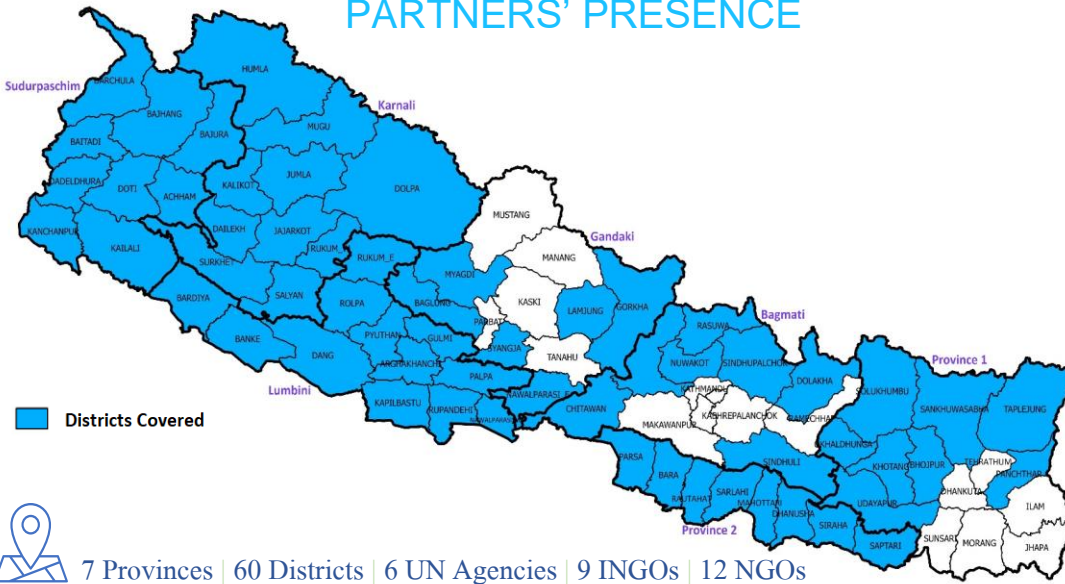

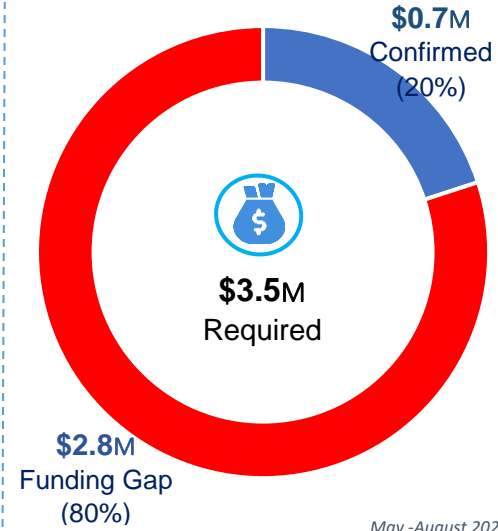

1,039,583 pregnant and lactating women reached via telephone counselling on breastfeeding

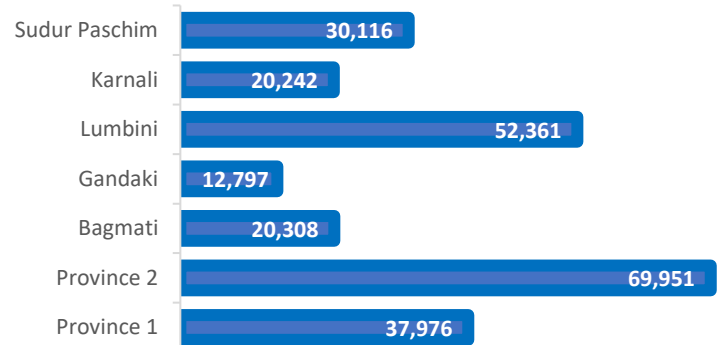
